The USS SC-1366 Muster Roll of the Crew cover sheet dated August 18, 1943, indicates that the ship was located at Wilmington, California. The USS SC-1366 was commissioned on August 18, 1943. All of the crew reporting on board August 18, 1943 were received from the SCTC, Terminal Island, California. Late in 1943, the USS SC-1366 was converted to USS PGM-8 at San Pedro, California. The final Report of Changes for PGM-8 is dated December 1, 1945. There is no final muster, but apparently there were still 17 crew members aboard on December 1, 1945. These men are listed as departing after December 1, 1945. Their departing rate is not known for certain, but i have listed their rate on the last muster, dated October 1, 1945 or on the Report of Change if they reported on board after October 1, 1945.
