The SC-1053 was commissioned March 17, 1943 and was converted to PGM-4 late in 1943. PGM-4 was decommissioned January 17, 1946.

James Tyson was transferred from PGM-4 to U.S. Naval Hospital, Long Beach, California, on 12 FEB 44, which establishes that PGM-4 was one of the ships that returned to San Pedro [said to be due to heavy seas] after leaving for Pearl Harbor on January 23, 1944. PGM-4 was at Pearl Harbor, Territory of Hawaii, by 25 FEB 44 when George Bilstein was received aboard from Navy No. 128 [Pearl Harbor].
