USS SC-1071 was commissioned on June 8, 1943. All of the crew reporting on board on the day of commissioning were received from the Reception Station, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. USS SC-1071 was converted to USS PGM-6 late in 1943. USS PGM-6 was decommissioned on January 17, 1946.
