The Report of Changes sheets that are included with the musters include the location of the ship and when it sailed from one location to another. Unfortunately, there is not a complete accounting for all locations in these records, but those provided in the musters are provided below. The ship's log contains a much more detailed account of the ship locations but I have not had access to the logs. In addition, reception and transfer information of crew members, in some cases, provides location information for the ship. In these cases, location is provided (date, crew member last name, location).
